## Medfield Animal Shelter Spay/Neuter Clinic

Instructions to prepare for your cat's surgery:

- Do not allow your cat access to any food after 9:00 pm the night before surgery. You should continue to provide them with water
- Please arrive between 7:45 am, and 8:30 am the day of the clinic
- Fill out the surgical authorization form mailed or emailed to you and bring it with you for quick and efficient check-in. This form can also be downloaded from medfieldshelter.com/spay
- Please bring any rabies vaccine records with you. Massachusetts law requires that all cats six months of age or older must be vaccinated against rabies by a licensed veterinarian
- We will vaccinate your cat if you don't have proof of a prior rabies vaccination
- Cats must be in a sturdy cat carrier with a small towel or blanket for comfort (one cat per carrier)
- Cats must weigh at least 3 lbs. and show no signs of illness (fever, nasal discharge, coughing, sneezing, weight loss, etc.)
- Payment is due upon arrival. Accepted forms of payment include exact cash, check, credit or debit card, or money order made out to Medfield Animal Shelter
